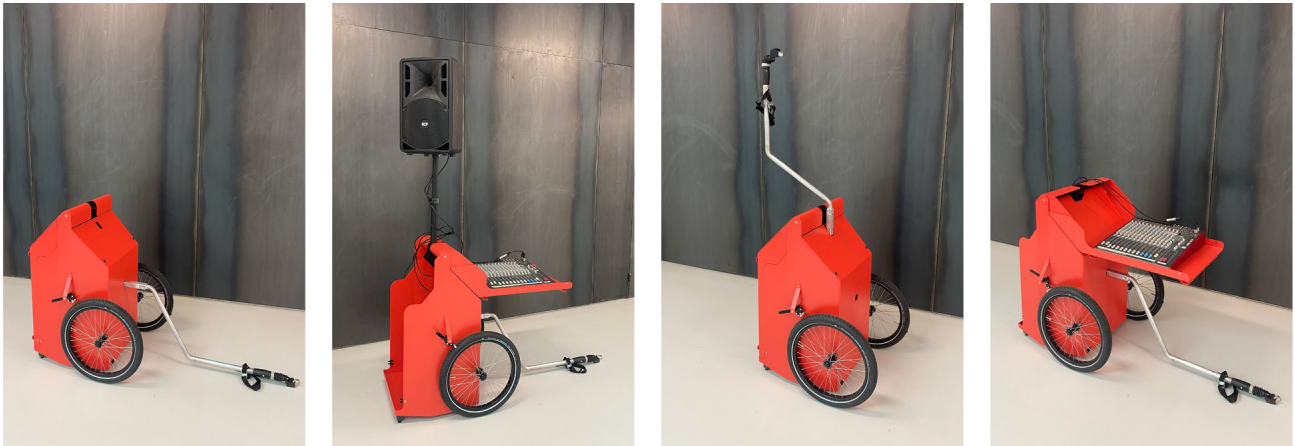


### **Informations about the new STADTWAGERL (city trolleys) - mobile equipment for public space**

The Angewandte aims to reach out to allow a public debate and perception of its activities. In order to strengthen and support events in public space and the relocation of events to public spaces, the Event Management has created the STADTWAGERL. They were developed by the artist and alumni of the Angewandte Valentin Ruhry and are available to all university members for university-related activities.

The STADTWAGERL are mobile and very compact solutions for realising smaller events in public space. Equipped with high-quality tyres, they can be pulled by hand or used as bicycle trailers. Only a power connection is required on site.

**Please note that due to the technical "equipment and infrastructure" an event registration or notification is legally required for holding events in public space.**

The STADTWAGERL can be reserved via the Event Management at [veranstaltungstechnik@uni-ak.ac.at](mailto:veranstaltungstechnik@uni-ak.ac.at) (Jakob Sigl and Thomas Mitterböck are the direct contact persons).

Use is limited to university-related activities and a loan form must be filled out and signed for borrowing.

**The units are equipped as follows:**

**Stadtwagerl #1:**

- active speaker
- 8-canal audio-mixer (2x XLR)
- 4 wireless microphones with receiver
- Storage space for laptop etc.

Examples of use: Panel discussion, intervention, performance, music feed, small live music formation. Extension with Stadtwagerl #2 possible (second loudspeaker, more audio channels).

**Stadtwagerl #2:**

- active speaker
- 16-canal mixer (12x XLR)
- Storage space for laptop etc.

Examples of use: Live music, performance. Extension with Stadtwagerl #1 possible (second loudspeaker, wireless microphones).

**Stadtwagerl #3:**

- Storage space (e.g. for mobile seating)
- Optionally equipped with beamer
- Storage space for laptop etc.

Examples of use: Screenings, presentations, transport Extension with Stadtwagerl #1 and #2 possible (sound reproduction, loudspeakers, microphones).

For smaller and even more mobile purposes, the Event Management also has two mobile loudspeakers that are equipped with a battery and thus do not require a power connection. They can also be borrowed from the Event Management team at [veranstaltungstechnik@uni-ak.ac.at](mailto:veranstaltungstechnik@uni-ak.ac.at).

**iRoller 10:**

- mobile loudspeaker with battery
- Connection for up to 2 microphones (1x XLR, 1x Jack)
- AUX IN or Bluetooth for music

Examples of use: Speech amplification, music feed

**Denon Audio Commander:**

- mobile loudspeaker with battery
- 1x hand microphone, 1x headset microphone
- 2 further microphone-inputs (XLR/Jack Combibuchse)
- AUX IN or Bluetooth for music
